BMFA & AMARC Recommendations

AMARC's Exit Lockdown Plan/Strategy

- MAX number of 8 people per flying session on site at any time
- 4 flying, 4 on the benches rotating
- Allow plenty of space between cars in car park
- Hand sanitiser should be considered an essential
- Maintain the 'Social Distancing' at ALL times (at least 2 meters)



- Pilot/flying line pilots to be 2 meters apart (club to mark or fence out area (see example) Adhere to a One Way system when entering and exiting Pilot 'Pens'/flying line (zone).
- Toilet is now available, hand sanitiser available in toilet. There will be no access to the to
 power generation so members must make their own arrangements, and no central charging
 table or facilities.

- Club house to remain closed unless in a emergency
- ONE Committee member on site if whenever possible
- Flying Days divided into 3 sessions,; mornings, afternoon & evenings
- Morning session 10.00 to 1.00 (3hr)
- Afternoon session 1.30 to 4.30 (3hr)
- Evening session 5.00 to 9.00 (4hr)

- You can now book 1, 2 or 3 sessions per day
